Armour Rock Price Increase

Following a recommendation to the West Coast Regional Council's Infrastructure Governance Committee Meeting earlier this month, it has been decided to increase the sale rate of Armour rock across all Regional Council quarries.

The price of Armour rock will increase at a rate of \$30.00 per tonne for sales to rating districts and \$35.00 per tonne for sales to the open market. Rubble will remain the same at \$2.00 per tonne.

Quarry Manager Chris Heath says an increase in sale price was recommended to the Committee due to inflationary adjustments in the rock sale price.

"The rock sale price has remained static over the last two years, however, we have had to look at increasing the current rates as external cost pressures have compounded in recent months."

The new price increases will take effect from 1 August 2024.
