Thank you for the opportunity to submit on the Resource Consent for Westland Mineral Sand co ltd proposed Heavy Mineral Sands Mining operation at Mananui.

I am opposed to the proposal for the following reasons:

Fitzherbert Court Motel

- I do not support the 24 hours a day operation of the Road transport of the Mineral sand to the port of Greymouth as it will result in an increase in heavy traffic past my motel causing increased disruption for my guests.
- Hokitika does not have a heavy traffic bypass therefore those up to 6 truck and trailer movements will go past my tourist accommodation business every hour, day and night. Breaking the restful sleep of my clients.
- The current overnight heavy vehicle traffic is very low, Grouped around 4am with the Milk tankers leaving Westland Milk products. The existing heavy vehicles are loud as they pass the motel. In addition to the train that passes behind the motel at 6am.
- The proposal will result in an additional 6 truck movements an hour, that would be one truck and trailer unit every 10 minutes through the night.
- Not only will my business be impacted by the noise and increase in heavy traffic. Residents along the whole route will be impacted, it will also result in an increase in maintenance required, causing further disruption when reseals and repairs are required, and costing Council and Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency.
- Hokitika is rebuilding our tourism destination image after the Pandemic disruptions and the increase in overnight Noise from Heavy traffic will taint that image.
